#### Location

#### Risks

The following risks are applicable to anyone taking part in this activity.

- Problems due to inadequate supervision.
- Traffic accident
- Medical issues, especially asthma and diabetes.
- Allergy to insect bites, stings and nuts.

#### Safety measures

- Staff: student ratio must be at least 1:6+1 for year 3 and 1:15+1 for years 4-6, not including Holt Hall Staff but wherever possible use a ratio of 1:10+1 for years 4-6. Staff: student ratio must be 1:15+1 for years 7-13.
- A member of staff must stay near to the estate road to slow any traffic and alert children to the presence of traffic.
- Students who use asthma inhalers must have them with them.
- Diabetics must have food with them.
- If any student or member of staff is allergic to nuts or insect bites or stings please ensure that Holt Hall staff are made aware of this so that precautions can be taken.
