Map Making and Triangulation

Location

Muckleburgh Hill, Weybourne and Bard Hill, Salthouse

Risks

- Problems due to inadequate supervision.
- Traffic accident risk when crossing road at Weybourne
- Danger of scratches, cuts and other injury from plants and by slipping or falling when climbing the hills. (This danger is greatest at Muckleburgh Hill).
- Danger from misuse of equipment.
- Minibus travel – students must follow all minibus rules i.e. Seatbelts must be worn, do not distract driver, no eating or drinking, do not remove seatbelt or attempt to get off until told it is safe to do so. Take care entering and leaving bus.

Safety Measures

- Staff student ratio must be at least 1:6+1 for year 3 and 1:15+1 for years 4-6, not including Holt Hall Staff but wherever possible use a ratio of 1:10+1 for years 4-6. Staff student ratio must be 1:15+1 for years 7-13.
- All students must be informed about how to carry out fieldwork safely.
- Students must be under control and watched by the leader at all times.
- Students should walk in single file on roadsides or narrow pavements and tread carefully in long rough grass and when climbing or moving about on the hills used, to avoid twisted ankles and foot injuries.
- Compasses and clipboards must be used properly and not swung round or used to push plants out of the way.
- Compass strings should be put onto clipboards, NEVER put round the student's neck.
- Students must be dressed suitably for the conditions and use sun block if appropriate.
- Diabetics must have food with them and asthma sufferers must have their inhalers. School staff should look after medications and bring items which may be required by the student concerned.
- Holt Hall and school staff must be made aware of any allergies to nuts, insect bites, stings, etc.
