Risks

The following risks are applicable to anyone taking part in these activities.

- Problems due to inadequate supervision.
- Problems due to young people getting lost.
- Problems with communication if young people are out in the estate.
- Falling out of tree
- Allergic reaction to bites, stings or nuts.
- Poisoning by plants.
- Injuries from improper use of equipment.
- Medical issues including asthma and diabetes.

Safety Measures

- Young people must stay on the lawns around the hall at break times.
- Young people under 16 must be appropriately supervised at all times. They are not allowed into the walled garden without an adult.
- Young people may not go into the woods at break time unless they are accompanied by an adult
- Young people may not climb trees.
- Some plants on the estate are poisonous. Children may not eat any part of any plant from the estate.
- Staff must ensure that asthma inhalers and food are accessible to those who may need them.
- All equipment must be returned to the games equipment store at the end of break.
